You said your priority was:	Anti social behaviour in Gas Works, Central, Etnam St, Spar Car parks. Vehicles congregating within the car parks, causing anti social behaviour and leaving litter.

We undertook:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • High visibility patrols by the safer neighbourhood team with a view to disrupting this behaviour, identifying persons responsible and dealing with them accordingly. • Several council exclusion letters from the car parks have been served on drivers, conducting the above behaviour. • Update 27/06/2017 <p>Patrols have continued within these areas. Throughout this month there has been a reduction of reports. SNT will continue to monitor and deal robustly will any matters brought to our attention.</p>
You said your priority was:	Anti Social Behaviour – Bridge Street Sport centre playing fields. Underage consumption of alcohol / littering and evidence of small fires.
Date set:	20/06/2017
We have undertaken:	<p>High visibility patrols targeted in those areas by the SNT with assistance of response officers to deter nuisance behaviour / identify those who are the main perpetrators.</p> <p>Update 27/06/2017</p> <p>Targeted patrols conducted within the location 23rd/24th June. Large group of youths dispersed by SNT. Those identified have been visited at there homes where advice offered to parents / guardian concerning the child's / teenagers activities.</p>
You said your priority was:	Anti Social Behaviour, Criminal damage and reports of drug use in The Grange, Etnam Street Car Park, Sydonia and The Priory with surrounding areas including the town centre.
Date set:	01/02/2017
We have undertaken:	<p>High visibility patrols targeted in those areas by the SNT with assistance of response officers. SNT are working closely with Leominster town council, Leominster in bloom and local business / resident in respect to issues identified as well improving youth provisions within the town.</p> <p>Update 26/06/2017</p> <p>Patrols have continued within these area's. Throughout this month there has been a reduction of reports within these area's. (Positive UPDATES)</p> <p>01/06 – a male was arrested near to Grange Crt for being in charge of motor vehicle whilst under the influence of drugs. 13/06 – two males were found in the possession of cannabis at Grange park, Leominster. Both were issued with street</p>

	cautions and the cannabis was disposed of by Police.

The West Mercia Police area and especially North Herefordshire remains low crime. Burglary

Attempt burglary to a property located near Barons Cross Road, Leominster during early hours of 01/06/17.

Criminal damage

Criminal damage to plants / containers located in School lane, Leominster during early hours of 06/06/17.

Incident 0011s 040617. Update: CCTV footage identifying two suspects causing damage / ripping plants from the containers, enquiries are on-going.
